What can I expect from palliative care?

Who is on the palliative care team?
Should I have a surrogate decision maker?
Will you explain my treatment options and the issues involved in making these decisions?
How will you communicate with me and my family about my illness?
If I am admitted to the hospital, will you continue to be involved in my care?
How will you partner with my doctors?
How will you help me if I experiencesevere pain or other symptoms?
What support do you offer my family and/or caregivers?
Are you available 24 hours?
What is the best way to reach youwhen I need you?
What resources do you recommend for me to learn more about palliative care?
